- > A current/unexpired operator's license from another municipality in the State of Wisconsin.

➤ A copy of intention/proof of Registration for the Responsible Beverage Service Course must be submitted.

The application must be completed by answering all the questions.

Omissions may result in denial of your application.

License fee is non-refundable and are to be paid at the time of filing the application form.

Parameters for Denial of an Operator (Bartender) License:

- Giving false or incomplete information, or misinformation, on the application.
- An arrest or conviction of selling alcohol to an underage person during the past 5-years.
- > An arrest or conviction of an underage person on premise with alcohol present during the past 5-years.
- Conviction of any substance abuse during the past 5-years.
- Conviction of driving under the influence of any alcohol or controlled substance during the past 5-years.
- > Conviction of allowing another person to use your operator's license during the past 5-years.
- Conviction of selling to an intoxicated person during the past 5-years.
- Conviction of selling alcohol without a license in the past 5-years.
- Conviction of any part of Chapter 125 State Statutes, not listed above, relating to alcohol beverages during the past 5-years.
- An arrest or conviction of charges related to the alcohol activities performed while selling/serving/bartending within the past 5-years.
- Any habitual law offender or felon where the circumstances of the charges substantially relate to the licensing activity.
- Convictions of illegal gambling during the past 5-years.

If a certificate of completion of the Responsible Beverage Service Course is required, it must be brought to the Clerk's office BEFORE your license application will be placed on a town board agenda for approval.

License expires 2-years after issue date rounding to the nearest June  $30^{\text{th}}$  expiration date.
